Open Catechism

The Family area shows existing enrolments and the action for a new application.

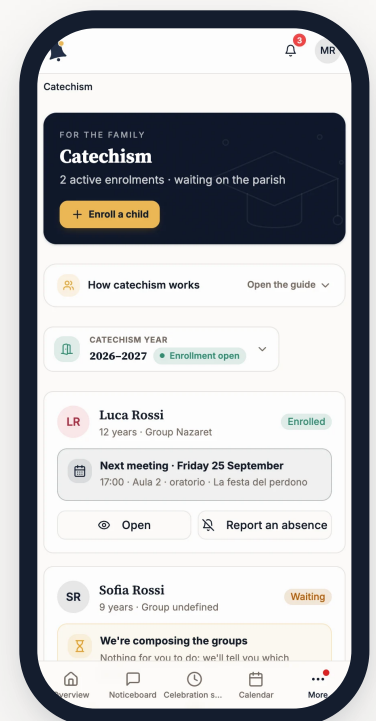


Fig. 1 From the app open Catechism and choose the Family area.

STEP 2 OF 5 · 2 MIN

Select Enroll a child

Open Enroll a child and, under Who do you want to enroll?, choose a person linked to the profile.

The person selected under Who do you want to enroll? is used throughout the workflow; verify name and date of birth.

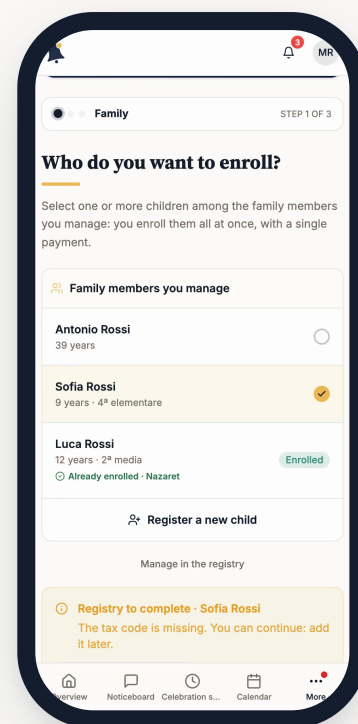


Fig. 2 Who do you want to enroll? with people linked to the family profile.

STEP 3 OF 5 · 2 MIN

Complete path and documents

Choose a group or preferences when requested and attach the documents shown by the workflow.

The sequence shows only documents and preferences configured for the selected year.

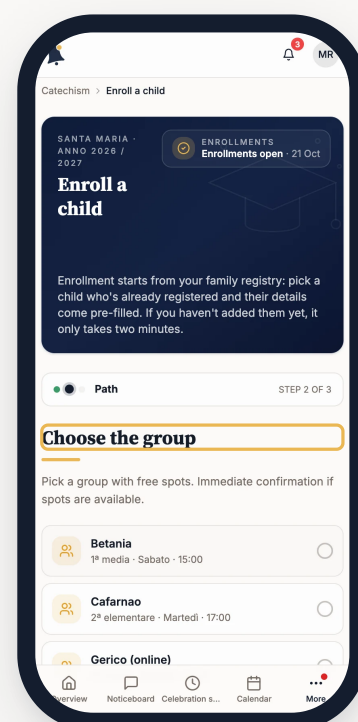


Fig. 3 After the preamble, educational covenant, and child choice, the flow shows the available groups.

Review agreement, consents and health

Read the agreement, complete required consents and enter health data only in the reserved fields.

Complete consents individually and use dedicated health fields rather than general notes.

5**STEP 5 OF 5 · 2 MIN**

Review and submit

Review the family summary and any fees, then use the offered submission action.

After submitting, return to Family and check the status shown beside the child's name.
